Nor are any former Miss Courir de Mardi Gras Queen is eligible to compete. The contestant must be of good moral character and must always conduct herself in a lady-like manner. Our Queen must be willing to attend all fairs and festivals listed in the Courir de Mardi Gras Queen's Agreement.

The contest is scheduled for Saturday, January 30, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Church Point Community Center.
